An Alternate Route to the High School Diploma

The Queens Library Adult Learner Program's **National External Diploma Program (NEDP)** is an applied performance assessment system that assesses the high school level skills of adults and out-of-school young adult. The NEDP evaluates the reading, writing, math, and workforce readiness of participants in life and work contexts. Most participants complete the program in approximately 6-8 months, depending on your skill level and the amount of time you can devote to the program. The ideal candidate is self-directed, want recognition of their learning and employment experiences, and prefer to demonstrate their knowledge in practical ways. Successful completion of the program means that the New York State Education Department will certify your credential and the Long Beach School District will issue your High School Diploma; thereafter, you may then apply to any college, just like any other high school graduate.

- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Must have at least a score of 9 or better on the TABE D on Math AND Reading
- Pass the CASAS Diagnostic Exam
