- be at least 21 years of age
- have at least a score of 9 or better on the TABE D on Math AND Reading
- pass the CASAS diagnostic test.

The **National External Diploma Program (NEDP)** assesses the high school level skills of adults and out-ofschool young adult: it evaluates the reading, writing, math, and workforce readiness of participants in life and work contexts. Most participants complete the program in approximately 6-8 months; and the the ideal candidate is self-directed, want recognition of their learning and employment experiences, and prefer to demonstrate their knowledge in practical ways. Successful completion of the program means that you will get your High School Diploma, then you may then apply to any college, just like any other high school graduate.
