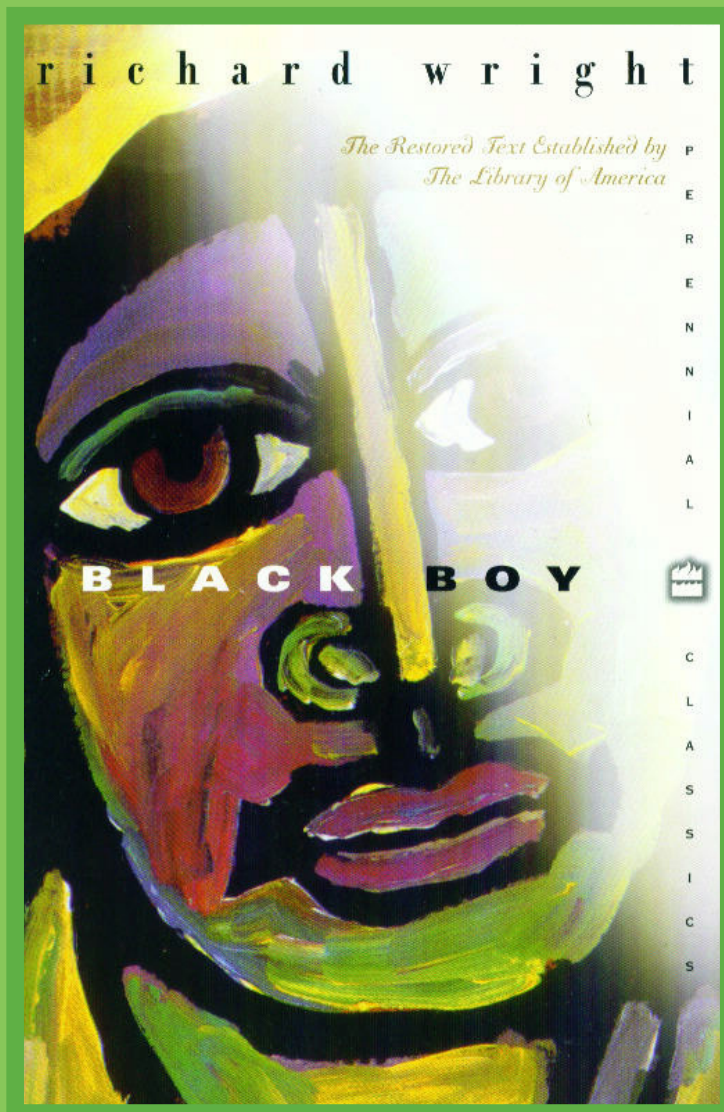
BLACK BOY
