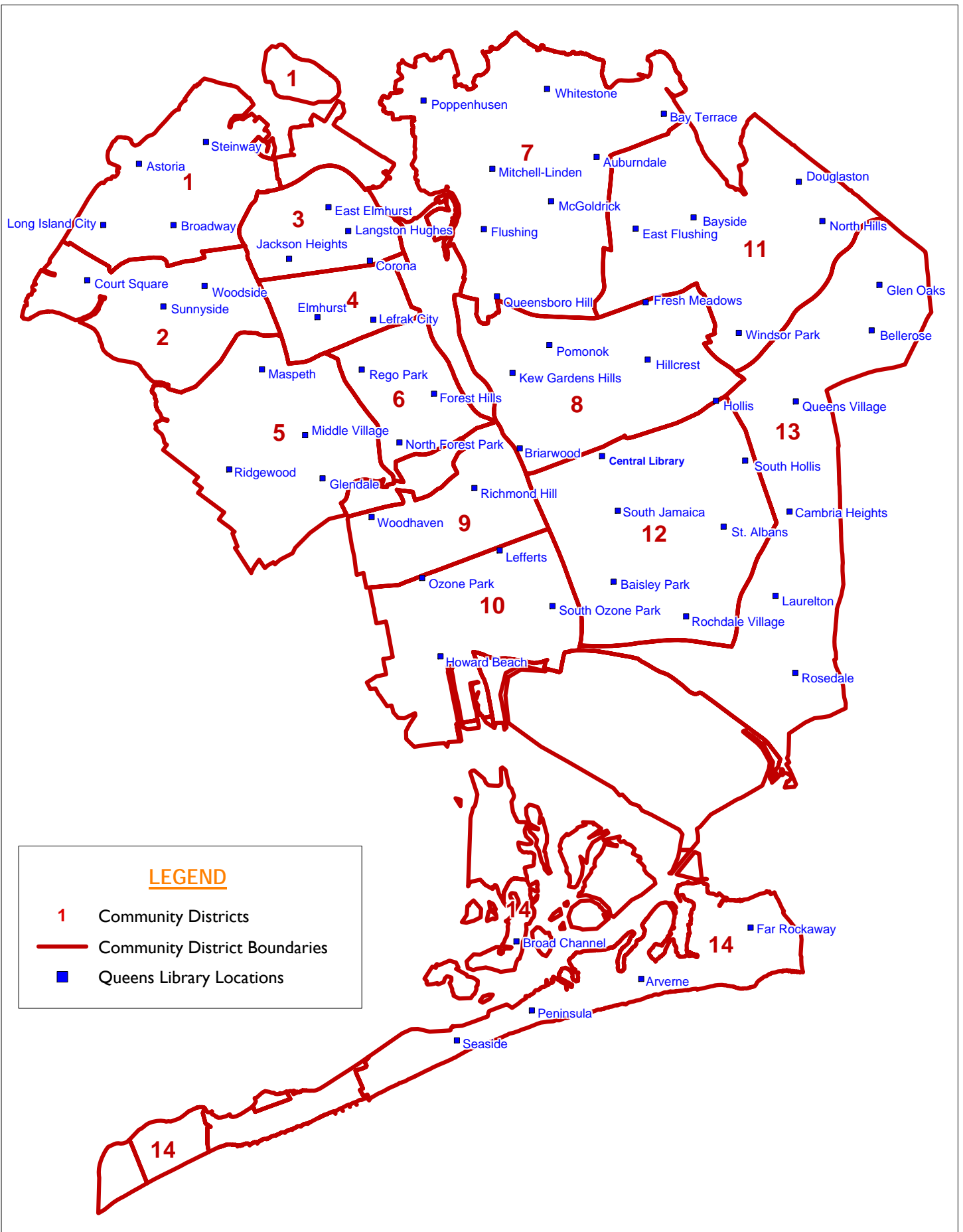
Quick Demographic Facts for Queens Community Districts

Providing the best customer service is one of the top priorities at Queens Library. Knowing our customers and communities is the first step of achieving that goal. This report is designed to give a demographic update for the 14 community districts in Queens. The 2005-2007 American Community Survey 3-Year Estimates for Census designated PUMA subareas was used because as the first multiyear ACS estimates, they have a larger sample size than the single year ACS estimates. The PUMA subareas for Queens also closely approximate Queens community districts even though they are not coterminous.

NOTE: Data are based on a sample and are subject to sampling variability. The degree of uncertainty for an estimate arising from sampling variability is represented through the use of a margin of error. But since the nature of this report is to provide quick demographic facts for each Queens community district, only the estimates, not the margins of error are cited here. 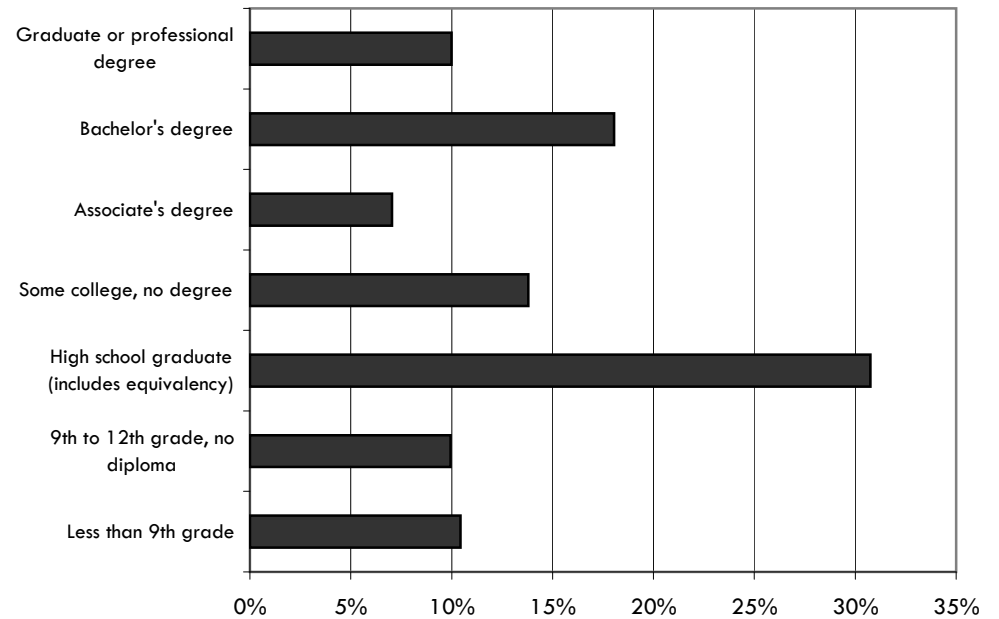

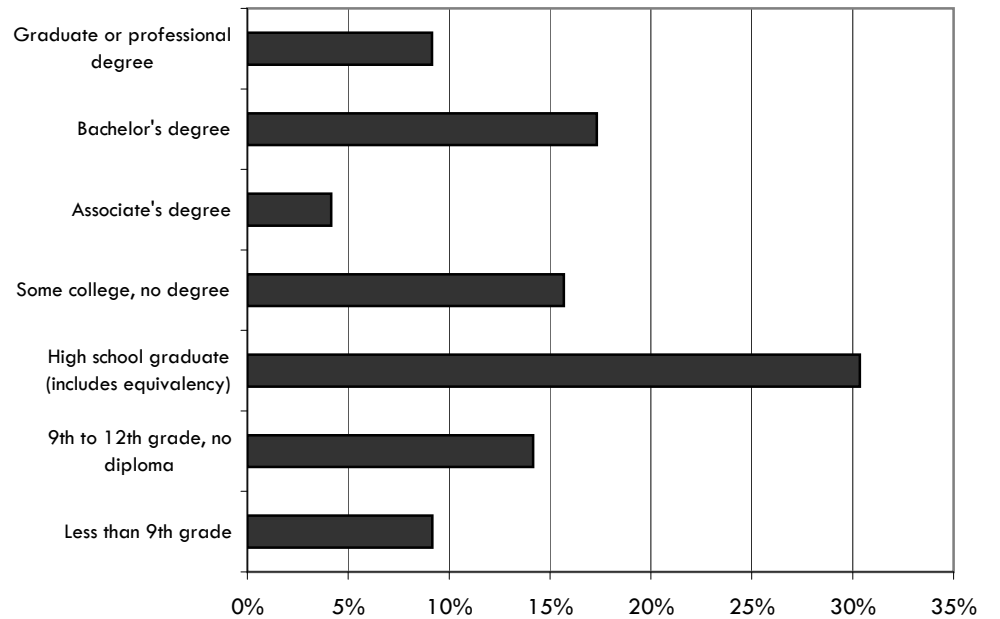
