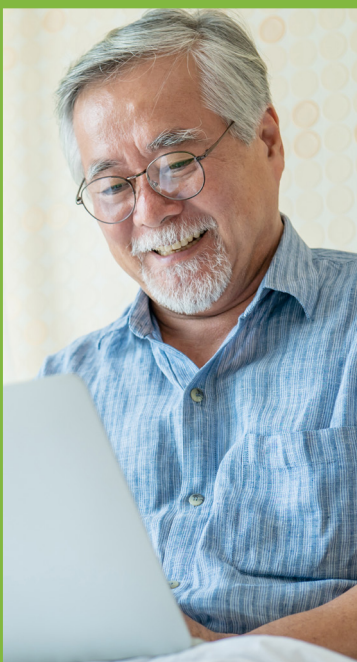

ATTENTION

IN-PERSON CLASSES (one class only)

A limited number of virtual classes will be offered. Only up to 25 students will be registered for each class.

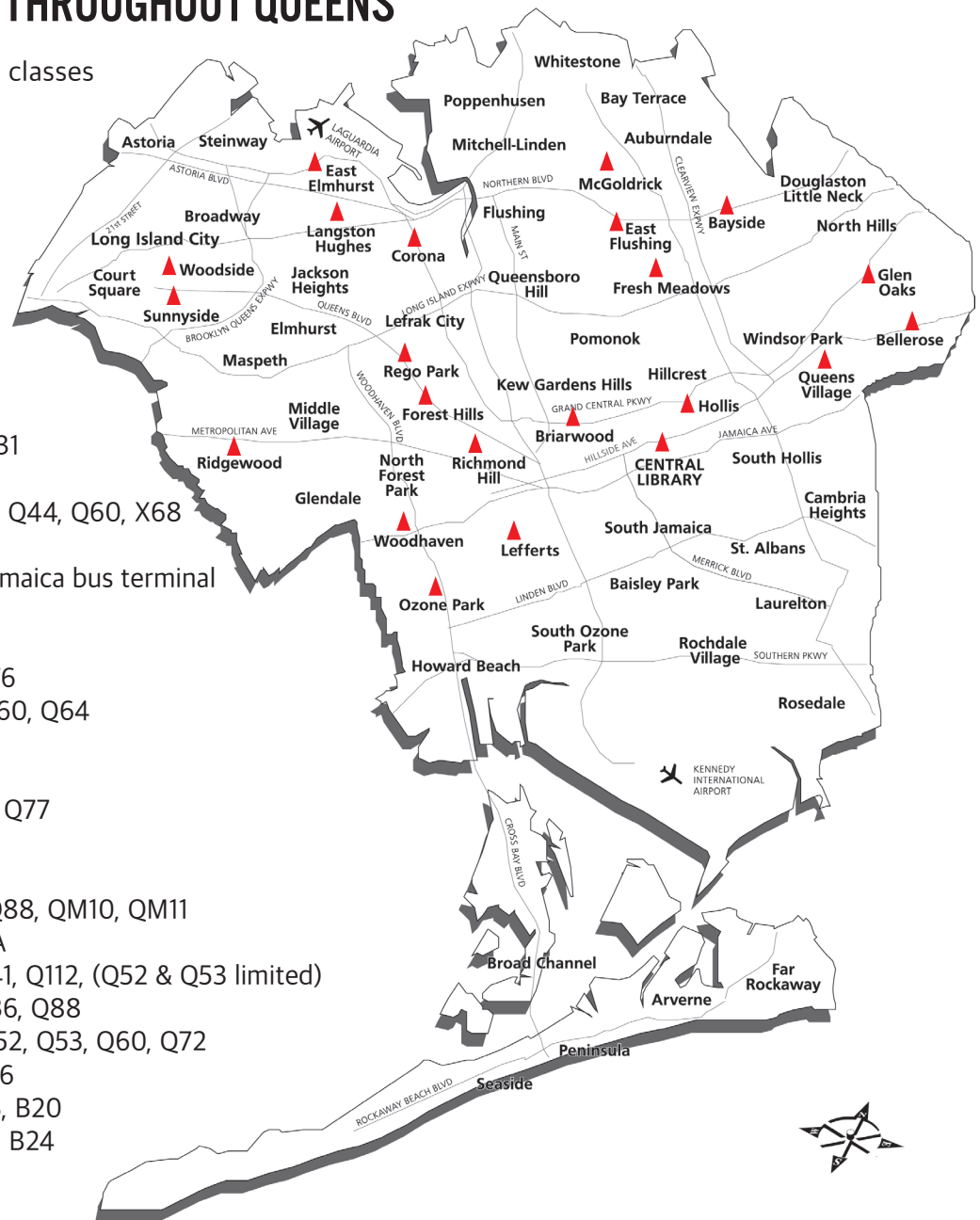
LIBRARY MAP SHOWING LOCATION OF COMMUNITY LIBRARIES THROUGHOUT QUEENS
