This is an action item seeking approval from the Queens Borough Public Library's Board of Trustees to enter into a First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Loan and Security Agreement ("Renewal Agreement") with TD Bank, N.A. ("TD Bank") for access to up to \$10 million in a revolving line of credit ("Line of Credit") secured by the Library's investment portfolio.

The original Board-authorized Loan and Security Agreement with TD Bank for a \$10 million Line of Credit was entered into on December 22, 2009 and incrementally renewed until October 31, 2022.

The Board then authorized an Amended and Restated Loan and Security Agreement ("Amended Agreement") with TD Bank, which re-established the \$10 million Line of Credit with an interest rate of the Library's choice of either (1) the Term SOFR Reference Rate for the Interest Period therefor plus one hundred fifty (150) basis points, or (2) a "Base Rate" equal to the greater of zero (0%) percent and the then-current rate of interest published by *The Wall Street Journal* from time to time as the U.S. "Prime Rate" less one (1.0%) percent. The Amended Agreement extended the Line of Credit from November 1, 2022 to October 31, 2023.

Current Status:

The Renewal Agreement proposed by TD Bank extends the \$10 million revolving Line of Credit from November 1, 2023 to October 31, 2024, on the same terms as the prior Amended Agreement.

Recommended Motion for Consideration by the Board of Trustees:

I recommend that the Board of Trustees authorize the President & CEO to execute the First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Loan and Security Agreement with TD Bank, extending until October 31, 2024 a line of credit in the amount of ten million dollars, secured by the Library's investment portfolio, on the same terms as the prior agreement.

Background:

This is an action item seeking approval from the Queens Borough Public Library's Board of Trustees to enter into a contract with Quality Facility Solutions Corporation for window cleaning services. The Board's approval is required pursuant to the Library's Purchasing Policy, which provides, in pertinent part, that contracts for building services and maintenance valued at more than \$50,000 shall require a formal competitive bid and be awarded to the responsive and responsible low bidder.

Quality Facility Solutions Corporation ("Quality Facilities Solutions") has been a prior provider of window cleaning services to the Library. In 2017, the Library awarded Quality Facility Solutions its last contract, and the firm performed well during the five-year term. In 2022, the Library issued a bid for window cleaning and, due to a limited response, canceled the bid. The Library awarded a limited term agreement with a contract value not to exceed \$50,000 to Cristi Cleaning Service Corporation.

Current Status:

On September 28, 2023, the Library issued an Invitation for Bids, Bid Number #0923-2, for window cleaning services. The bid was advertised in the New York City Record, BidNet, and New York State Contract Reporter, posted on the Library's website, and notification of the solicitation was sent to over five hundred (500) firms using the NYC M/WBE directory, the NYS Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Directory, and a bidder's list compiled by the Library.

The bid sought to engage the expertise of qualified firms to provide window cleaning services at specific locations. The bid also specified that the Library reserves the right to schedule or not to schedule locations, and that the Library has the right to not proceed with a window cleaning in a given year, or to schedule multiple cleanings per year. Additionally, the Library reserves the right to add other library locations during the term of agreement. The following firms submitted bids:

Cristi Cleaning Service Corporation did not provide its required vendor qualification information with its bid and, as such, the firm was deemed non-responsive and notified of this determination. Quality Facility Solutions submitted the lowest responsive bid. The Library thoroughly reviewed the firm's experience, financial stability, references, background, completed vendor responsibility questionnaire, and the PASSPort database in assessing the vendor's responsibility. This review did not identify any negative findings or raise any integrity issues that would adversely affect an award to the firm.

According to the NYC Comptroller's web page, CheckBook NYC, Quality Facility Solutions has been awarded over \$15 million in contracts since 2018 from various City agencies including the Department of Design and Construction, Department of Citywide Administrative Services, Department of Education, and Department of Environmental Protection.

A references provided by Quality Facility Solutions indicated that the firm performed well. A reference from NY Developers and Management, a construction management firm, indicated that Quality Facilities Solutions has performed over \$2 million in services each year for several years and that they were very satisfied with the performance of the firm. A reference from Ray Builders Inc., a general contractor and construction management firm, stated that Quality Facility Solutions performs work in a professional and qualified manor and has always met expectations.

Recommended Motion for Consideration by the Board of Trustees:

I move that the Board of Trustees authorize the President and CEO to execute a contract with Quality Facility Solutions Corporation for window cleaning services for a three-year term with two one-year options to renew at the Library's sole discretion, at the attached rates.
