- Q1. Looking to get a full pricing on bid prior to the upcoming bid # 0425-1 If you can please forward to me before the new bid date so we can properly submit our bidding information
- A1. This question seeks information that is not required to submit responsive bid.
- Q2. Before I get started I wanted to clarify one thing. The Successful Bidder must be certified by Green Shield or Eco Wise (or an equivalent deemed acceptable in the sole judgement of the Library) Are you able to confirm if my Quality Pro and/or GreenPro certification would suffice?
- A2. The Library is researching this question and is extending the bid.
- Q3. To prepare a responsive and accurate bid, we would also like to request guidance on scheduling site visits to a selection of the Library's locations — especially those listed for bi-monthly service, as well as the Central and Flushing branches. Please advise if these walkthroughs should be coordinated through your office or a designated contact.
- A3. The Library is researching this question and is extending the bid.
- Q4. On Form #4 Pricing- "Comprehensive remediation" termite baiting is listed with rodent proofing, ants, cockroaches, wasps, gnats, etc. We are unable to give a flat rate pricing for this due termite service being charged per linear foot. Can we add another line stating what we charge for termite services?
- A4. The Library is researching this question and may revise the bid and pricing sheet. Bidders are not to provide alternative pricing. The Library is extending the bid.
- Q5. On Form #4 Pricing- the libraries that are listed for bimonthly services are also listed again for monthly services. Does this mean some libraries will be getting treated 3x a month?

- Q6. Under "II. Scope of Work C. Reporting & Documentation" bullet point #4 states that reports should be made available preferably through website access setup for Queens Library accounts. Would we be able to upload IPM's to a Dropbox for QPL to access it?
