IN-PERSON CLASSES (one class only)

- All applicants will be pre-tested to determine their level of English and placed accordingly.
- Bring the completed attached intake form.

VIRTUAL CLASSES (one class)

A limited number of virtual classes will be offered. Only up to 25 students will be registered for each class.

SPACE IS LIMITED AND WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS

An English test will be given for class placement. Approximately 25 students will be registered per class. Others will be put on a waiting list or referred to our Adult Learning Centers or other programs.

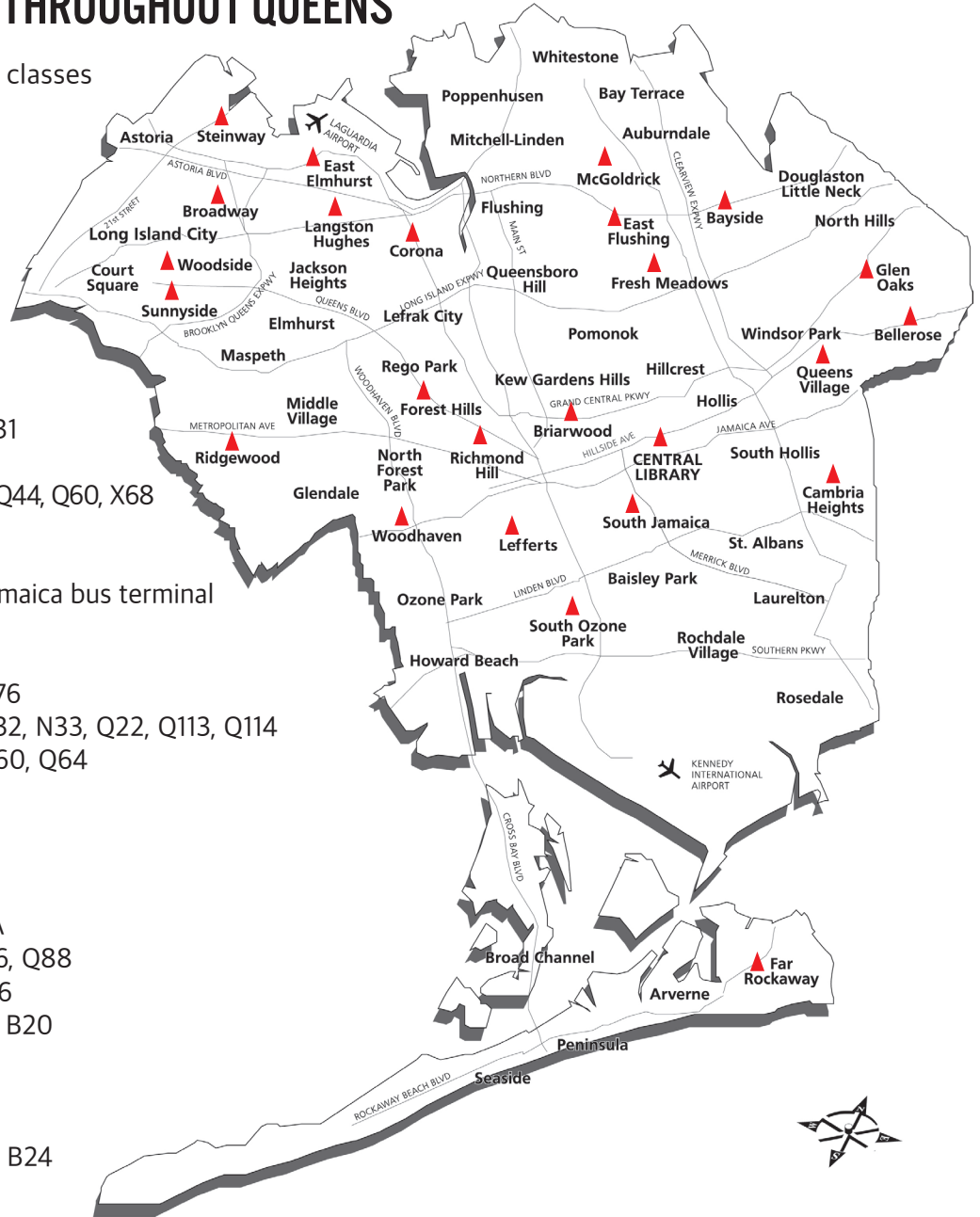
LIBRARY MAP SHOWING LOCATION OF COMMUNITY LIBRARIES THROUGHOUT QUEENS
