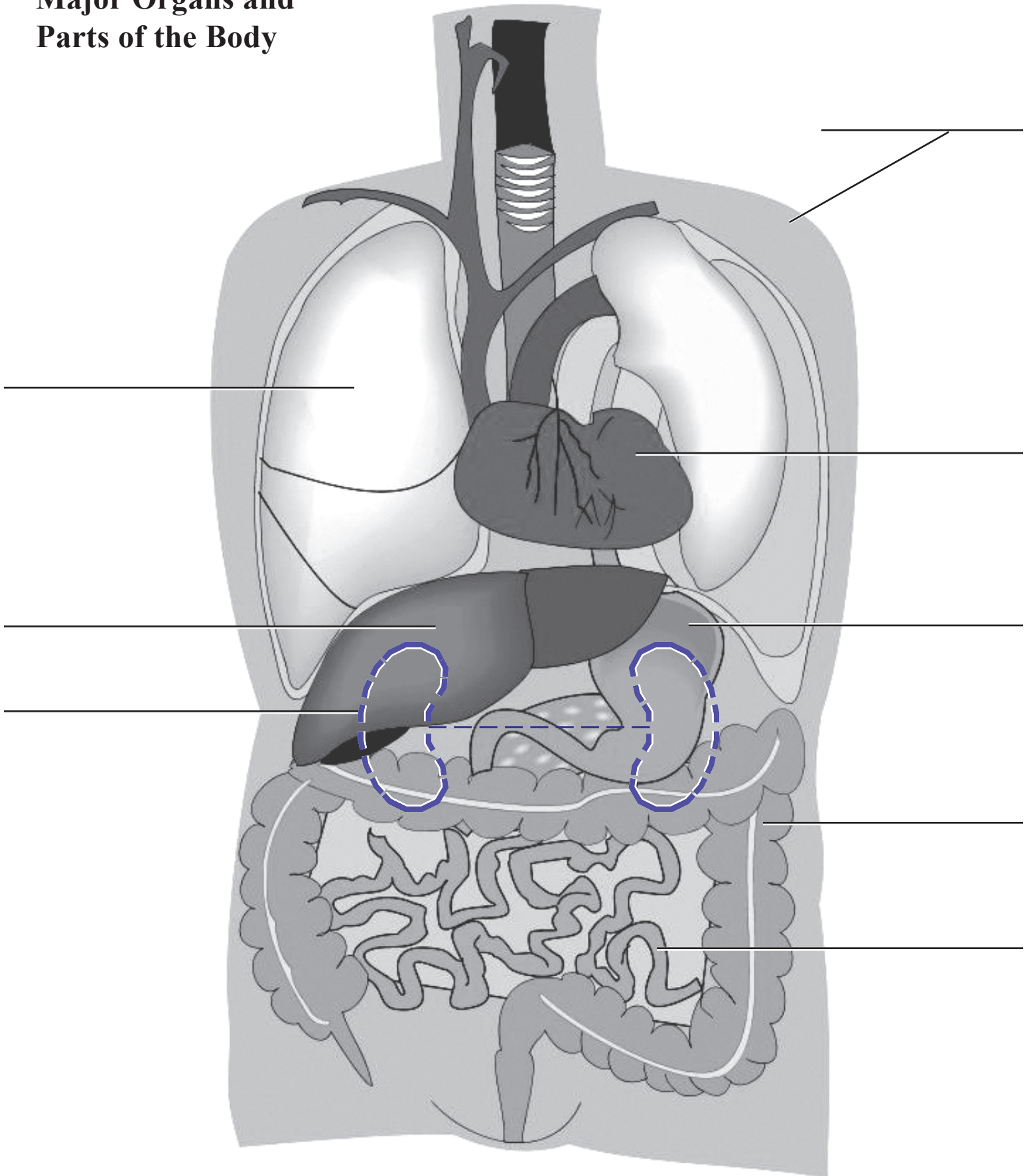


## Major Organs and Parts of the Body

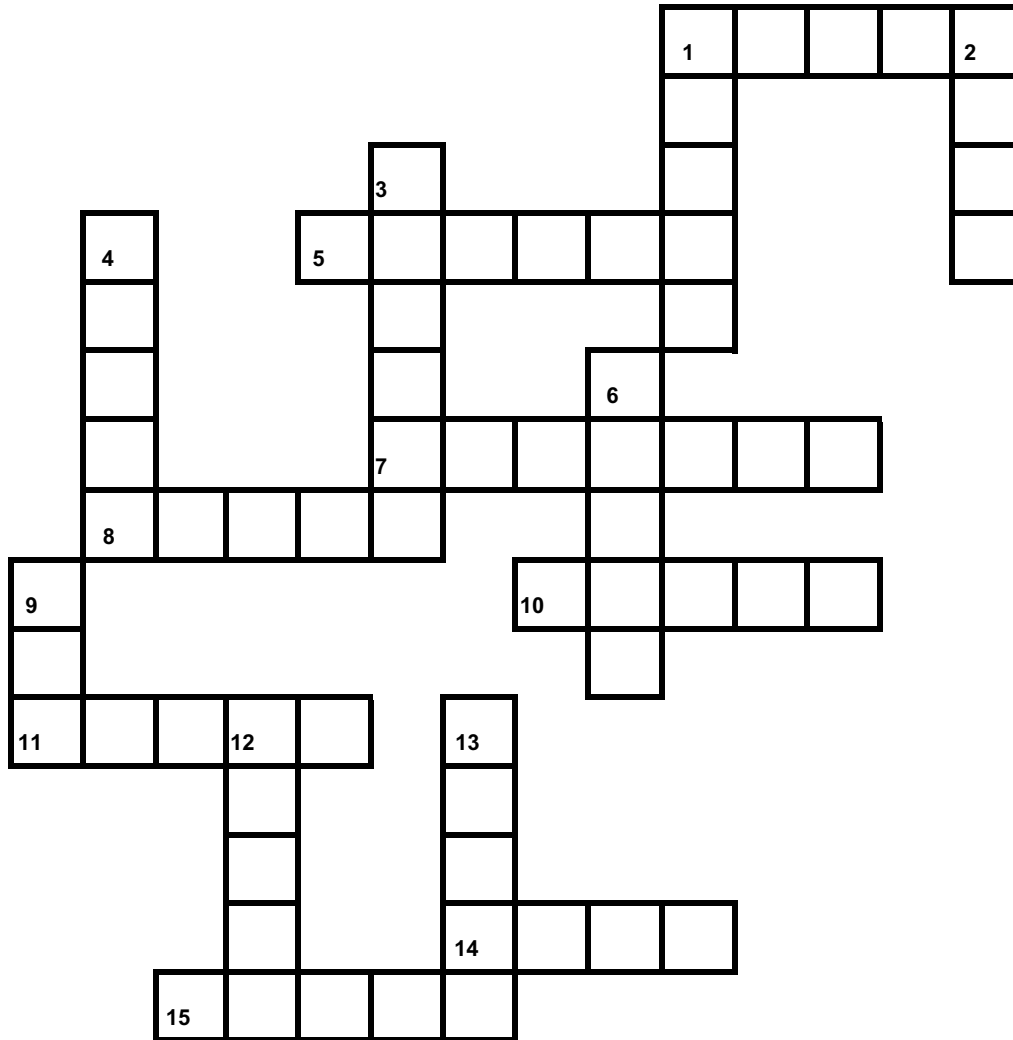
